- An Australian citizen, or a holder of an Australian visa with working rights; and
- Assessed as suitable for training

- BSBPEF202 Plan and apply time management
- BSBTEC101 Operate digital devices
- BSBTEC203 Research using the internet
- FSKDIG002 Use Digital technology for routing and simple workplace tasks
- VU22362 Engage with simple texts for employment purposes
