Recommended study plan for part-time students

Duration 2.5 years

Timetable Ranging between 1.5 - 2.5 days per week, you will be required to undertake on campus learning on Tuesdays (5:00pm - 8:00pm) and Thursdays (9:00am - 5:00pm). Depending on the semester, further online learning may be scheduled on Tuesdays (1:00pm - 4:00pm) and/or Wednesdays (9:00am - 12:00pm). Online learning may include flexible delivery including live online sessions, recorded lectures and self-directed learning.

Work placements are normally 40 hours per week in blocks, with the exception of Primary Health Care, which can be allocated as individual days or in blocks.
